

Town of Rich Square  
Board of Commissioners Special Meeting  
Tuesday, August 27, 2024 – 1:00 pm  
Rich Square Annex Building

The Rich Square Board of Commissioners held a special meeting in the Town Administrative Building located at 109 N. Main Street in Rich Square, North Carolina on Tuesday, August 27, 2024. Mayor Victoria Newcombe called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm and Commissioner Godwin gave the invocation.

Elected officials in attendance were Mayor Victoria Newcombe, Commissioner Peggy Cary, Commissioner Raymond Joyner, Commissioner Larry Godwin, Commissioner Linwood Bryant, and Commissioner Charles Eason.

Town staff was out of town to attend training, so the minutes were recorded by the Mayor.

The purpose of the Special Meeting was to review and approve an amended Town Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Commissioner Godwin informed the Commissioners that the budget previously submitted and approved was not properly balanced. Various adjustments had to be made, including: additional tax revenue to be received from the County, FICA percentages to be correctly calculated, and math errors in the Ordinance. Commissioner Godwin explained the revisions and a new budget was in front of the Board to be reviewed, approved, and sent to Natalie Rountree at the Unit Assistance Department of the NC Department of the Treasury.

Commissioner Linwood Bryant made a Motion to Amend the Proposed FY 2024-2024 Town of Rich Square Budget and submit it to Ms. Natalie Rountree for approval. Commissioner Raymond Joyner seconded the motion. By unanimous vote, the Board voted to approve and submit the Amended FY 2024-2025 Budget for the Town of Rich Square.

Commissioner Linwood Bryant moved and Commissioner Charles Eason seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously and the August 27, 2024 Special Meeting was adjourned at 1:45.
